- Explore food from Japan and Greece



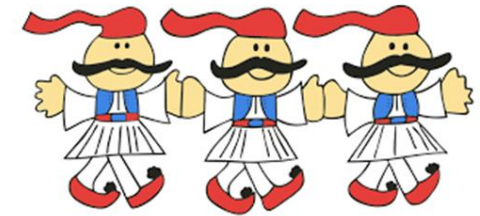
