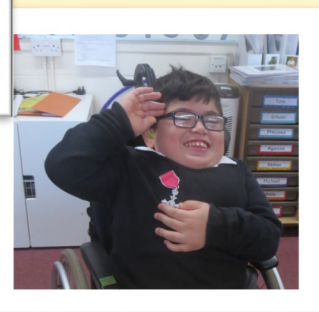
### Christmas Lunch
